Mountains and Valleys Scarf

This pattern reminds me of a trip I took through the Welsh countryside, driving through a series of mountains and valleys. When I saw the colors in this Wollmeise skein, I couldn't help but make a pattern out of it!

Materials

Yarn: 1 skein (575 yards) Wollmeise Pure 100% Merino Superwash (Fingering weight) Color: "Auster"

Needles: Size 1.5 (2.5 mm), straight or circular

This pattern is adjustable to fit various yarn and needle sizes.

Directions

<u>Section 1:</u> Cast On 5 stitches

Pattern: Row 1 (RS): sl1, k2tog, k to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 Row 2 (WS): sl1, kfb, k to end *Every 2 rows, 1 stitch is increased*.

Repeat these 2 rows until there are 67 stitches, or when you are 1/2 to 2/3 of the way to your desired scarf length.



Section 2:

A: (see Chart 1) Row 1 (RS): sl1, k2tog, p to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 Rows 2 & 4 (WS): sl1, kfb, p to end Row 3 (RS): sl1, k2tog, k to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 Repeat Rows 1-4 **3** times

B:

Row 1 (RS): sl1, k2tog, k to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 Row 2 (WS): sl1, kfb, k to end Repeat Rows 1-2 **3** times

C:

Repeat 4 Section A 5 times

D:

Repeat Section B 5 times

E: Repeat Section A 8 times

F:

Repeat Section B 8 times

Section 3:

A: (see Chart 2) Row 1 (RS): sl1, k2tog, *p1, k1, rep from * to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 Rows 2 & 4 (WS): sl1, kfb, p to end Row 3 (RS): sl1, k2tog, k to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 Repeat Rows 1-4 8 times

B: (see Chart 3)
Row 1 & 3 (RS): sl1, k2tog, *p1, k1, rep from * to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1
Row 2 & 4 (WS): sl1, kfb, p to end
Repeat Rows 1-4 4 times

C:

Rows 1 & 3 (RS): sl1, k2tog, k to last 2 stitches, kfb, k1 Rows 2 & 4 (WS): sl1, kfb, p to end Repeat these 4 rows once.

Finishing

BO using the <u>lcelandic Method</u>, which will provide a nice rolled edge. Weave in ends and block to preferred size.

Key

BO = Bind Off K = Knit KFB = Knit, then knit into the back of the stitch and pull both off needle P = Purl SL1 = slip one knitwise

Charts:

Note charts are read from bottom to top, R to L on RS and L to R on WS.

K on RS, P on WS

• P on RS, K on WS
